

PE Days

School PE days are as follows:

Class 2 (Reception, Year 1 and Year 2) – Tuesdays and Thursdays

Class 3 (Year 3 and Year 4) – Thursdays and Fridays

Class 4 (Year 5 and Year 6) – Mondays

Please could you provide your child with a pair of trainers or gym shoes that they can keep on their peg in school so they have access to them at all times for outdoor PE lessons and outdoor learning/activities. They do not need PE kit as we are continuing to provide these for all children and take care of them in school.

Swimming Lessons

Class 4 (Year 5 and Year 6) will go swimming on a **Thursday** until further notice. Please ensure your child brings their swimming kit to school on a Thursday; swimwear, towel, swimming hat and goggles (if required).

If your child does not have a swimming hat, these can be purchased at the swimming venue at a cost of £2.50 each. If you would like to purchase one, please send the money to school with your child.

If there are any changes to the swimming schedule, Mrs Pinkowski will let you know via in app message on Arbor or by text message as soon as possible.

School Meal Price

As previously communicated before the summer holidays, from this month, September 2023, the price of a school meal is increasing to £2.50 per day.

Within the next couple of weeks, we will be offering all children in school the chance to have a bagel at the start of the school day. The bagels will be heated up in school and be offered to the children on the way in to school or taken to the classrooms during registration.

School Uniform

Please remember our school colour is **RED** and that the children should wear unbranded plain **BLACK** shoes. Their polo shirts should be **WHITE** and trousers, dresses or skirts **GREY/BLACK**.

We would like to continue with our PRELOVED uniform rail in school. If you have any uniform that you don't need any more and that is in clean and in good condition, please send it into school. We will then advertise to all parents what we have in stock so that people will be able to come into school to find something suitable for their child, if they want to.

School will continue to provide and take care of the children's PE kits, with the exception of PE shoes. **Reminder:** Please remember to send trainers or gym shoes into school, preferably ones that can stay in school on their pegs so they have access to them at all times for both outdoor PE and outdoor learning.

Collection – 11.45am at the Early Years/Class 1 gate.

Nursery 30 Hours

Drop off – 8.45am at the Early Years/Class 1 gate.

Collection – 3.15pm at the Early Years/Class 1 gate.

Nursery Afternoon (2-year-olds)

Drop off – 12.30pm at the Early Years/Class 1 gate.

Collection – 3.30pm at the Early Years/Class 1 gate.

School (Reception – Year 6)

The school gates open at 8.45am, children start school at 8.55am.

Collection – 3.15pm at the school gates.

Year 5 and year 6 children ONLY

If you would like to give permission for your child to walk home alone after school, please contact the school office for the consent letter. The letter needs to be signed and returned to school in order for us to allow your child to walk home alone.

Attendance

Good school attendance is crucial to a child's academic success. We monitor and analyse our school attendance and the attendance of each child weekly and as soon as attendance dips below 95%, this could result in a phone call or a request for an attendance meeting in school.

If your child is absent from school, please **REMEMBER** to contact the school office on their first day of absence before 9.00am.

Parking

Please can we remind all parents and carers to be considerate when parking around school at the beginning and end of the school day. Please be mindful of the children and pedestrians that will be around at these times.

The application process is now open.

If your child's birthday falls between 1 September 2012 and 31 August 2013 your child will start Year 7 at a secondary school in September 2024.

You must apply for a school place as there is no automatic transfer from primary school to secondary school.

If your child's birthday falls between 1 September 2019 and 31 August 2020 your child will start Reception at an infant or primary school in September 2024.

You must make an application for your child's school place as there is no automatic transfer from nursery school to an infant or primary school (Reception intake).
