

Autumn One in Class 3



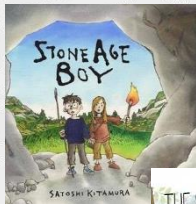
English

This half term we will continue with the 'Read Write Inc' programme to develop our reading skills. Those children still working on their phonics will learn new letters & sounds each week. Children who have completed this will work through our spelling program.

In writing, children will be focusing on learning how to write a narrative using a range of different skills, such as expanded noun phrases and time connectives. We will continue to practice Reading Comprehension with our class novel as well as shorter texts.

Maths

History

**From the First stone age people to the end of the Roman occupation:
How did Britain change?**

During this unit of work, children will be learning about Prehistoric Britain and how it changed with time. We will be focusing on the three periods within the Stone Age, then moving onto the Bronze Age and the Iron Age.

General Info

Your child will be receiving a home reading book this term. They will choose a book to read at home and at school, then will take a quiz on at school before they change it. Please support your child's reading development by reading for 5 minutes every day.

Homework should also be returned on a Wednesday. Homework will be sent home on Fridays to encourage further practise of something that we have already practised in school, and will have a maths or English focus.



Science

How could we cope without electricity for one day?

This question will allow children to explore electricity.

Children will reflect on their own experiences with using electricity, and consider how and why we rely on it so much. Children will also observe and experiment with circuits, investigate how electricity is generated, and consider the roles of conductors and insulators in electrical currents.

D&T

Can we go fly a kite?

Children will create their own kite this term. They will discover and compare different designs of kite, why certain parts are needed to fly a kite effectively, and will use their design skills to consider the criteria of their kite before they make them.



PE

Children have PE sessions twice a week.

On a Monday and Thursday afternoon the children will cover gymnastics. Please ensure children have trainers or gym shoes in school.

Music

Let Your Spirit Fly

The children will be listening to and appraising songs looking at pulse rhythm and pitch. They will learn to sing the song 'Let Your Spirit Fly' practicing the verses, chorus and the bridge.

Children will learn how to log onto our Class laptops using their own personal logins. Our Purple Mash learning this term will cover:
