Attendance & Medical Appointments

Please remember that if your child is unwell, you must phone the school office and inform us. This can be done by speaking directly to Miss. Smith in the office or by leaving a voicemail on the absence voicemail inbox.

The reason we ask this of parents / carers is largely for safeguarding purposes, so that we are all aware of where the children are if they are not at school for any reason.

We would also like to remind you that any medical appointments need to be made outside of school hours wherever possible, or after 2pm as a last resort. We do also require evidence of the appointment. This could be a letter received as confirmation of the appointment or by asking for a slip at the office for completion by the medical professional.

School Uniform

Please ensure that you send your child to school in full school uniform daily (except for PE days at the moment). This means a polo shirt, black or grey trousers / skirt and appropriate black shoes. Jewellery should be limited to a pair of stud earrings and make up and nail polish should not be worn.

Dinner Money

If you pay for your child's school meals, this needs to be paid weekly via the ParentPay app. If you need to have your login details sent out, please contact Miss. Smith in the office and she will arrange this for you. School meals are £2.10 per day.
