Holocaust Report

I can describe how and why Jews were subject to Nazi prejudice and discrimination during the war.
I can recall and report key facts about the events of the Holocaust.

Imagine:


It is December 1945. You are a journalist, who has been asked to write a report about the Holocaust at the end of the war.

You have been asked to investigate the following:

- What is the Holocaust?
- Who was affected by the Holocaust?
- How did it feel to be a Jewish person living during the war?
- What did Jewish people do to try and protect themselves?
- Did all Germans agree with Hitler and the Nazi party?
- Why was the persecution of Jews and other minority groups allowed to continue? Why did people not try to stop what was happening?
- How many people died in the Holocaust?
- What happened in the concentration camps?

Think carefully about the details you will need to include. Plan your report carefully keeping related information together. Consider what you will write about in each paragraph.

You may present your report how you choose-perhaps you could prepare a full written document or write an interview script that includes quotes from people who experienced the war first-hand. Photographs or pictures may also be used to support the information you include.



Consider how you would present these answers in your report. You could write them out by hand, or create a word/PowerPoint document. Send me a picture of the final result.
